Foster Personal Hope:

- Light candles at a family meal and share ways you have experienced hope.
- Attend one or more of the Jubilee Year deanery retreats on hope.
- Read Pope Francis' document on the Year of Hope: **SPES NON CONFUNDIT (Hope Does Not Disappoint)** Available on the diocesan website.
- Set aside an hour to read and reflect on these passages and how you have experienced hope in your own life: Romans 5:3-5 & Romans 8: 24-26
- Ask friends and family to share their stories of hope.

Carry Hope to Others: Be a "Pilgrim of Hope"

- Share a positive and hopeful message on your social media.
- Send an encouraging scripture or text message to someone who needs it.
- Do an anonymous random act of kindness.
- Identify someone in your life and write them a letter (or draw a picture.)
- Look up local non-profit and charitable organizations. What opportunities are there to serve or support? Choose one you are passionate about and learn more.
- Visit the elderly in nursing homes or the homebound in your community.
- Serve at the local soup kitchen or create "hope bags" for the homeless.
- Go through your home and find clothing, shoes, or other items to donate.
- Donate a box of diapers to a local organization.
- Participate in parish efforts of prayer.
