Application of Statement of Purpose to Jubilee Year 2025

We, the current parish Council of St. Stephen’s, dedicate ourselves to embodying the Statement of Purpose. Firstly, “forming one welcoming People of God” by acknowledging and reaching out, in person, to isolated people and people in recovery from trauma or addiction. Secondly, “to grow into a strong community of believers, sharing our lives in the Holy Spirit” by taking Our Lady of Guadalupe, Patroness of the Americas, as a model of faithful enculturation of Christian life and as an example of infusing Gospel values into the existing cultures on the reservation. Thirdly, “to grow into a strong community of believers” by supporting the longevity of lay and ordained ministers on the reservation in order to allow the necessary years for them to become immersed in the culture and ways of the Shoshone and Arapaho people.
