All are welcome to attend the third Jubilee Year Pilgrims of Hope Retreat on Saturday, July 12, 2025, at Saint Matthew Church, Gillette, beginning at 9 am, and closing with Mass at 5 pm. The retreat focuses on hope for enthusiasm for life and the young. This theme coincides with *Spes Non Confundit, paragraphs 9 and 12. Bishop Steven will open the retreat by discussing hope and the sources of hope: Word of God, Holy Spirit, Paschal Mystery, and Saints of Hope. Participants will join in Eucharistic Exposition and Benediction, and engage in the Spiritual Conversation and a Mercy Hour.*
