Special Collection for Gaza

Bishop Steven has received a request from the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops for an **urgent special collection to aid the people of Gaza**.

The letter from the president of the USCCB states:

“It is with great pastoral concern for the ongoing crisis in Gaza that I write to you today. Our Church mourns the terrible suffering of Christians and other innocent victims of violence in Gaza and surrounding areas who are struggling to survive, protect their children, and live with dignity in dire conditions. The Holy Father continues to call for a cease fire and for aid to enter the territory, noting with great sorrow that ‘Gaza is starving.’

Given the extraordinary nature of this crisis, I ask you to consider taking up a special collection to provide humanitarian relief and pastoral support for our affected brothers and sisters in Gaza and surrounding areas in the Middle East ... The situation in Gaza and across the Middle East cries out for the assistance of the Catholic community of the United States. I ask that you take up this collection and send funds ... as soon as possible.”

In response to this urgent request, Bishop Steven has asked that parishes take up this collection the weekend of **August 23–24**, or as soon as possible. Funds will be forwarded through the Diocese of Cheyenne to ensure assistance reaches those in need quickly.
